Every fortnight our dedicated volunteers produce and dispatch around 60 minutes of local news on a memory stick free of charge to our listeners.

Alternatively, the latest copy can be downloaded from the [HTN website](#) or listened to on the [Talking News Federation website](#) or streamed from an Alexa smart speaker if an Alexa Skill is installed on the device.

## About us

We are a charity which produces a free fortnightly audio version of local news and information for blind and visually impaired people living in and around the Havant Borough.

Familiar voices read articles taken from the Portsmouth News, Hayling Herald, and other community newsletters.

## Funding

Our service is completely free. Staffed by volunteers, we receive no public funding. Our income comes from legacies and donations.
